## Highlighted Poster session

- As a Highlighted Poster presenter, you are required to provide a poster for mounting in the Highlighted Poster board area on your assigned day. (Poster board mounting and removal times are listed below.)
- Your Highlighted Poster presentation is 12 minutes in length, including an 8 minute presentation and 4 minutes for Q&A.
- If you do not bring a second poster to mount in the Highlighted Poster theatre during your scheduled session, then please remount your poster in the Highlighted Poster theatre a **minimum of 15 minutes** prior to the session start time.
- Remember to return your poster to your assigned poster board at the end of the Highlighted Poster session.

## Poster sessions – general information

- Posters are presented according to their Learning Track.
- Poster sessions are held in the Community Forum located in Exhibition Halls BC on the Exhibition Level of the Vancouver Convention Centre (West Building).
- Posters are available for general viewing during the Community Forum hours. There will be specific viewing times when authors are asked to be present to discuss their poster and answer questions.
- Be sure to check the Final Program to reconfirm the date, time and poster board number of your presentation(s). It will be available electronically at the end of September on the CCC website [www.cardiocongress.org](http://www.cardiocongress.org), and will also be distributed on-site in Vancouver.

## Poster Mentor program

A Poster Mentor circulates, visiting each Poster Author (trainee) during the assigned time period when poster authors (trainees) are present. Poster Mentors provide feedback to the trainee on the following key areas:

- Originality of idea/concepts
- Benefit to colleagues/literature
- Quality of Research (Method/Results/Data)

There is no judging or identification of winners. The purpose of the program is strictly to provide valuable feedback to the trainees.

## Poster board specifications

Posters must fit within the following dimensions:

- Width: 91" (2.3 m)
- Height: 45" (1.14m)

Boards will have an identification number located in the top left corner measuring approximately 5" high x 8" wide (12.5 cm x 20 cm).

Velcro dots will be available to affix posters to the boards.

## Poster mounting and removal schedule

Poster presenters are asked to mount and remove their posters on their assigned day during the below specified times. CCC is not responsible for posters. Any posters left on display beyond the scheduled viewing time **are removed and discarded**. When mounting/removing your poster, please use the Poster Presenters entrance to the Community Forum.

The Poster Presenters' Information Desk is located within the Poster Area, and is staffed during poster mounting/removal times, as well as when the Poster Area is open for viewing.

Additional velcro dots are available from the Poster Presenters' Information Desk.

## Presenter registration

All presenters **must be registered and their registration fees for CCC paid** in order to receive their access badge, which grants them admission to CCC. This badge must be worn by all presenters and participants in order to enter scientific sessions. Submitting your abstract or accepting an invitation to present at CCC does not automatically register you for CCC.
